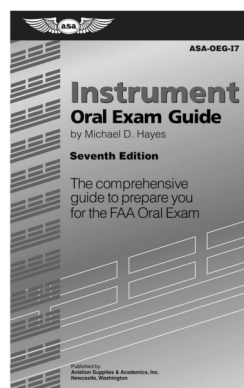
Oral Exam Guide Updated New Seventh Edition: Instrument

These exam guides are written to help prepare applicants for their oral exams with FAA examiners.
