## **Train Like You Fly** **A Flight Instructor's Guide to Scenario-Based Training**

**Scenario Based Training** (SBT) has become industry standard. Unlike maneuver based training where individual maneuvers are relatively isolated and learned virtually out of context, SBT is about the big picture and the integration of all the elements necessary for successful flight. By following structured scripts, SBT teaches students to consider all aspects of a flight—every flight—from beginning to end. Although SBT has been well received, unfortunately there aren't many guidebooks for pilots and instructors in its usage and day-to-day application, until now.

ASA's new *Train Like You Fly* by Arlynn McMahon explores scenario-based training extensively. In this book the author provides the key ingredients for making a good pilot and shares practical techniques to bring it all into the cockpit.
