Instrument Flight Instructor and Helicopter Commercial Pilot/CFI Practical Test Standards Updated

Newcastle, WA—The FAA has released two new Practical Test Standards (PTS), last updated in 1996 (Helicopter CFI) and 2006 (CFII). The new standards are effective January 2007.

Fundamental to a successful checkride, each PTS guide is written by the FAA and details the skills and knowledge that must be demonstrated before an examiner can issue a certificate or rating to an applicant. Used by instructors, students, and examiners to prepare for, review, take, or issue the checkride. The PTS also list the knowledge and experience prerequisites, the levels of skill that must be demonstrated, and describe background study and reference materials.

The PTS is *the* guide for students, instructors, and FAA-designated examiners to know what exactly is expected on a checkride. ASA reprints the most current popular FAA Practical Test Standards in handy cockpit-sized guides. Effective dates, updates, and PTS not printed by ASA are available as free downloads from the ASA website (www.asa2fly.com) so instructors can be certain they are using the most current information. Each PTS book is softcover, 5-1/4" x 8-1/4".
