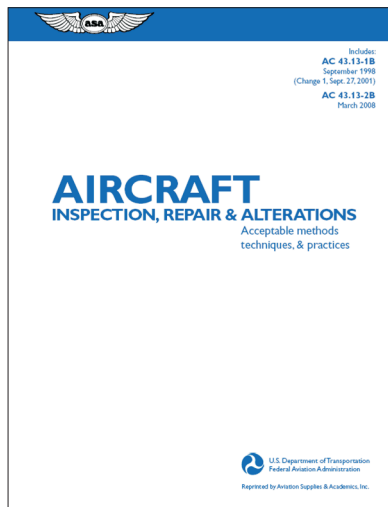
## **FAA Advisory Circular 43.13 Updated Aircraft Inspection, Repair and Alterations**
