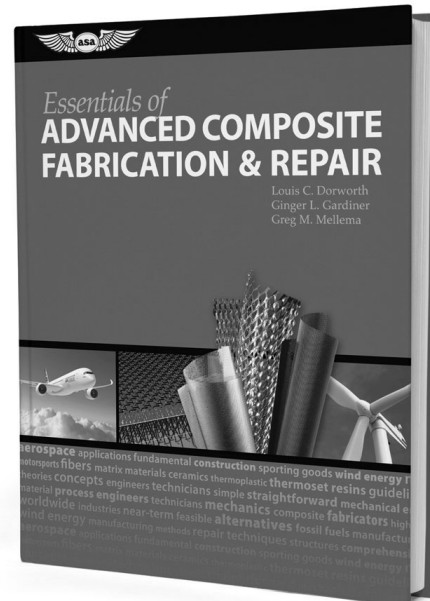
## New Composites Textbook from ASA
