## **ASA G1000 Course Approved for WINGS Credit!** **Computer-Based Tutorial Helps You Maintain Proficiency and Currency**

The new and revitalized *WINGS* program is in full gear at [www.faasafety.gov](http://www.faasafety.gov). Among its many incentives, participating pilots who complete at least the Basic Phase of the *WINGS* program need not accomplish the flight review requirements of 14 CFR part 61. Now ASA’s *Complete G1000 Course* can be used to satisfy part of the knowledge track requirement of the Basic Phase. Pilots who remain active participants in the *WINGS* program achieve the added level of safety and professionalism experienced through adoption of a consistent recurrent training program.

Under the umbrella of the FAASTeam the *WINGS* program is a tremendous resource available to all U.S. pilots. As stated in part on the *WINGS* portal at [www.faasafety.gov](http://www.faasafety.gov), “Regular proficiency training is essential to the safety of all pilots and their passengers. Each pilot must take a personal interest in their safety and that of their passengers. The *WINGS– Pilot Proficiency Program* is designed to help each pilot construct an educational curriculum suitable for their unique flight requirements.”

*The Complete G1000 Course* from ASA is an interactive, computer-based program written and presented by Master CFI and 2007 National Flight Instructor of the Year, Mike Gaffney. The FITS accepted course is a comprehensive tutorial that helps pilots transition from steam-gauge “round dials” to the glass cockpit environment. The course provides a safe, efficient, and convenient platform that allows pilots to become proficient in the operation of the G1000 *without* running up the Hobbs. Pilots will gain practical operational knowledge of the G1000, become familiar with its “knobology,” learn the keys to an effective scan, interpret system malfunctions, and much more.
