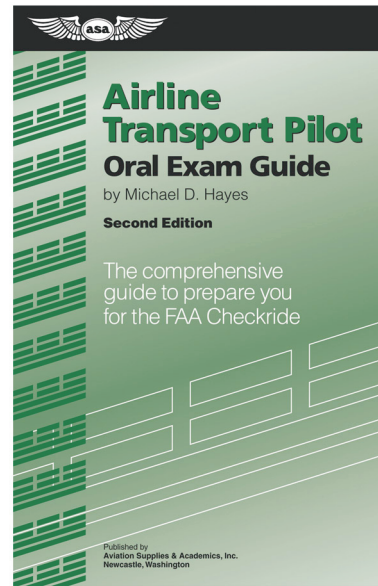

ATP Oral Exam Guide Updated
